

Taylor Swift's Engagement Ring: Design, Diamond, Cost, Designer & Meaning



Taylor Swift's engagement ring has quickly become one of the most talked-about celebrity engagement rings, attracting attention for its large diamond, vintage-inspired design, and distinctive yellow-gold setting. Taylor Swift and Travis Kelce announced their engagement in August 2025, revealing a ring that looks noticeably different from many modern celebrity engagement rings.

The ring features an old mine brilliant-cut diamond in a yellow-gold, bezel-style setting with hand-engraved details. It was designed by Kindred Lubeck of Artifex Fine Jewelry, whose vintage-inspired work had previously caught Taylor's attention. The Story Behind Taylor Swift's Engagement Ring

The engagement ring became public when Taylor Swift and Travis Kelce announced their engagement on August 26, 2025.

The announcement showed the couple together in a flower-filled setting, with Swift wearing the new ring on her left hand. Their announcement quickly became one of the biggest celebrity engagement stories in recent years.

The ring attracted almost as much attention as the engagement itself. Its unusually large-looking diamond, warm yellow-gold setting, and antique-inspired appearance immediately separated it from many modern celebrity engagement rings.

When Did Taylor Swift Get Engaged?

Taylor Swift and Travis Kelce announced their engagement on **August 26, 2025**. The couple shared the announcement through social media, using the playful caption, "Your English teacher and your gym teacher are getting married." The engagement followed their highly publicized relationship, which began attracting widespread attention after they were first linked in 2023.

Who Proposed to Taylor Swift?

Travis Kelce proposed to Taylor Swift. Kelce later worked with jewelry designer Kindred Lubeck to create the engagement ring rather than simply selecting a finished ring from a conventional luxury collection.

When Did Taylor Swift First Show Her Engagement Ring?

Taylor showed the ring publicly as part of the couple's engagement announcement in August 2025. The ring later received additional attention through public appearances, including its 2026 red-carpet debut, when photographers captured

much clearer views of the design. British Vogue described the March 2026 appearance as the ring's red-carpet debut.

Who Designed Taylor Swift's Engagement Ring?

Taylor Swift's engagement ring was designed by Kindred Lubeck of Artifex Fine Jewelry. This is one of the most important confirmed details about the ring.

Lubeck is known for distinctive jewelry that combines unusual stones, vintage-inspired designs, and detailed hand engraving. Her work caught Taylor Swift's attention before the engagement itself.

Who Is Kindred Lubeck?

Kindred Lubeck is an independent jewelry designer and the founder of Artifex Fine Jewelry. Her work is particularly recognizable for its antique-inspired character and hand-engraved details.

The Taylor Swift engagement ring brought her work to a dramatically larger audience. Vogue reported in April 2026 that Lubeck subsequently launched **Artifex Bridal**, a collection of engagement rings, wedding bands, and related jewelry inspired by the style associated with her work.

How Did Travis Kelce Choose the Designer?

The story behind the designer is one of the most personal details associated with the ring. Taylor explained that she had previously shown Travis a video featuring Kindred Lubeck's work because she thought it was beautiful.

She did not expect that casual moment to influence her eventual engagement ring. Travis remembered the designer and later worked with Lubeck to create the ring.

When Taylor saw the finished piece, she recognized the designer's style. That made the ring meaningful for a reason that has nothing to do with its size or price. Travis had remembered something Taylor genuinely liked.

What Did Taylor Swift Say About the Ring?

Taylor has spoken publicly about realizing who designed the ring. She explained that she had shown Travis the designer's work roughly a year and a half before the engagement and that he had apparently been paying attention.

Her reaction when she saw the completed ring was essentially that she recognized the designer immediately. That story helps explain why the ring feels highly personalized rather than like a generic celebrity engagement piece.

What Does Taylor Swift's Engagement Ring Look Like?

Taylor Swift's engagement ring has a large, elongated center diamond surrounded by a warm yellow-gold setting.

The design looks antique-inspired rather than ultra-modern. The diamond has an old mine brilliant cut, while the setting uses a bezel-style edge and detailed engraving.

The Overall Design

The ring combines three major visual elements:

- A large old mine brilliant-cut diamond
- Warm yellow gold
- Detailed hand engraving

Together, these details create a ring that feels historic, romantic, and handcrafted. Rather than allowing the diamond to dominate through a minimal setting, the design makes the metal and engraving part of the visual identity.

The Old Mine Brilliant-Cut Diamond

The old mine brilliant cut is one of the defining characteristics of Taylor Swift's ring. Old mine diamonds are associated with earlier diamond-cutting traditions and are known for proportions and facet patterns that differ from modern brilliant cuts.

They can have a higher crown, smaller table, larger culet, and broader facets than a modern round brilliant. That creates a different type of sparkle.

Instead of the precise, highly symmetrical appearance associated with modern diamond cutting, old mine diamonds often have more individual character. This is one reason Taylor's ring looks vintage even though the overall ring was custom made for her.

Is Taylor Swift's Ring Cushion Cut?

This is one of the details that has caused confusion in coverage of the ring. The diamond is generally identified as an **old mine brilliant cut**, while its outline appears elongated and cushion-like.
